Goal: Children will develop a strong sense of wellbeing, empowering them to feel safe, included, and confident in their learning and relationships.

Quality Area 1: Educational Program and Practice

Responsive relationships experienced with educators, ensuring every child feels safe, included and valued.

Design data collection tool for tracking progression of children's wellbeing.

Quality Area 2: Children's Health and Safety

Strengthen safe arrivals policy and risk assessment.

Intentional teaching and scaffolding of body safety awareness and hygiene routines, in alignment with the Child Protection Curriculum.

Quality Area 3: Physical Environment

Investigate installation of shade sails above the slides and swings, to support children's access to this regulatory movement input throughout the day.

Quality Area 4: Staffing Arrangements

Provide continuity of staffing to support Negotiated Goodbyes and relational routines throughout the day.

Quality Area 5: Relationships with Children

Responsive Relationships with OT, embedding skills within educator practice; *We are present, have warm faces, welcome your return, wait and name, serve and return, are predictable, mirror feelings, soothe, connect and guide, delight*

Quality Area 6: Collaborative Partnerships with Families and Communities

Completion of site Reconciliation Action Plan, in consultation with local community working group.

Quality Area 7: Governance and Leadership

Review service philosophy, creating a clear and succinct vision for Angle Vale Preschool.
